Film, Television and Electronic Media

The main purpose for modifying the FILM AS-T was to add the new course **MTEC 125: Audio for Visual Media**, which will allow students to fulfill the List A, Area 1 (Audio) requirements with one, 3-unit course, rather than two, 2-unit courses.

UC Transferability Status

ALL New CCN courses approved by CPC in Fall 2024, must be rereviewed for UC transferability in July 2025.

Fall 2024, CPC approved UC appropriate courses, will be submitted to UC for review and elective approval in July 2025. Once approval is received (usually by September 1) a UC designation will be retroactive to Fall 2025. Articulations can then be pursued. These decisions will be published in ASSIST and in our online catalog sometime in early Fall.

Institutional and Regional Accreditation

There are new guidelines from the CCCCO regarding accreditation requirements for courses that we can accept from other institutions. Previously we would accept only courses from "U.S. Regionally Accredited institutions." This has now changed to "Institutional Accreditation," which includes both Regional and National accreditation agencies. Many of the new institutions under the National category have previously been unacceptable and apply to CTE coursework. The list of National Accreditors can be found at this link:

<u>Special Note:</u> UC will continue to accept pass along coursework exclusively from the six U.S. Regional Accreditors; CSU will also accept "nationally recognized institutional accreditation." However, for CALGETC, only courses from Regionally Accredited Institutions are acceptable.
