# Earn English Proficiency

For graduation, students must demonstrate English reading and writing proficiency by completing 30 English credits with a grade of D or better.

## **Earn Mathematics Proficiency**

For graduation, students must demonstrate math proficiency by completing 20 math credits with a grade of D or better. Five of these credits must be in Algebra, or the equivalent.

\*Students may demonstrate English and/or Math proficiency through the successful completion of English and/or math courses from the Adult High School, another accredited high school, or through successful completion of college-level English and/or math courses.

### Earn Residency

Students must complete 20 credits in residence. Students may earn residency in a variety of ways: successful completion of 4 Adult High School courses, 6 college units at MiraCosta College, or any combination of credit and noncredit courses which is the equivalent of 20 high school credits.

#### **CASAS Assessments**

Students will be asked to regularly participate in CASAS reading and mathematics assessments throughout their time in the program. These assessments monitor learning gains and final post assessment(s) are done prior to program completion and the awarding of a diploma.

# **Catalog Rights**

To retain catalog rights, a student must maintain continuous enrollment. A one-semester leave does not terminate catalog rights. A two-semester leave (Fall/Spring or Spring/Fall) will result in the loss of catalog rights and returning students will have to re-apply to re-enter the program upon their return.
