## **Keys to codes on Evaluated Prior College Credit Transcripts**

General guidelines for codes/notes on transcripts that have been evaluated:

## All transcripts

- Regional accreditation and type of units (semester, quarter, or other) are highlighted on the transcript key or listed on the upper part of the first page of the transcript.
- Substandard grades are circled (anything lower than a 'C')
- Repeated courses, academic renewals, any courses with a grade of 'W', and substandard grades that don't impact GPA (such as NP or other similar grades), are lined out.
- Notes other than course equivalencies will be preceded by a symbol (ex: %, #, \$,
   @). Course(s) marked with a symbol will have a written explanation at the bottom of the transcript.
- All courses are evaluated for equivalency (coding: =Dept###) and for all 3 General Education (GE) Plans and areas (Plan A/ Plan B/ Plan C). For example, if GEOL1 from another college is determined by the evaluator to be equivalent to our GEOL 120, the coding would be: '=120'. If a course is not equivalent but can be used for GE, then you'll see something like "≠ A2/A3/-"or "≠ C/C2/3B."
- If course has been coded as equivalent, it can usually be certified in General Education Plans A, B & C however the MiraCosta College course is certified in those patterns. The main exception is courses from other California community colleges. Please check ASSIST to verify GE for these courses. The evaluator will add specific GE areas next to the equivalency if it is certified in different areas than our course.
- If a course is applicable to a GE area, it is also applicable to the following related Liberal Arts Area of Emphasis: Arts and Humanities, Mathematics and Sciences, and Social Behavioral Sciences. For example: course GEOL120 is coded as applicable to Plan A Area B; Plan B-Area B2/B3, and Plan C-Area 5A/5B. This course meets the spirit of our Liberal Arts Mathematics and Sciences degree. - "NDA" = Not Degree Applicable, "NT" = Not Transferable, "UD" = Upper Division,
   "≠" or "No=" = Not equivalent "=XXX" = equivalent to Dept XXX,

- Units will be calculated and shown as: units attempted (UA), units completed (UC) and grade points (GPTS). And listed by course level: cumulative (CUM), degree applicable (DA), and transferable (TR)
- The evaluator will have signed and dated under units/GPA area.
