This general education certification pattern can be subject to change year by year, but students are assured that courses taken to meet this pattern will be honored if they are approved for the academic year that the course is completed. **Courses on this list are approved effective Fall 2022 and are valid through Summer 2023**.

Certification of this general education pattern is not a CSU admission requirement, except when students are completing an Associate Degree for Transfer to a California State University. Students are strongly advised to work with a MiraCosta College counselor to develop an educational plan that includes general education and major preparation course work

Credit will not be awarded for both the honors and non-honors version of a course.

Courses listed in two different areas may be used in either area but not both.

Consistent with CSU admission policies, MiraCosta College will certify courses in Area A or B4 that have been completed with a minimum grade of "C-" or better.

Students with continuous enrollment (attendance in at least one semester per calendar year at a CSU or CCC or a combination of the two) prior to Fall 2021 may choose to complete the Plan B pattern without Area F and with the 9 unit Area D requirement.
