

JOURNAL ARTICLE - WITH DOI

A digital object identifier (DOI) is a unique series of numbers and letters assigned to some journal articles. A DOI is often listed on the first page of an article (or sometimes in the header or footer).

For articles without a DOI give URL of journal's home page.

When citing information from an *entire* website, just give the URL of the website in the text of your paper:

APA STYLE

Citing sources requires a brief **in-text citation** and full details of each source on a final **References** page. For additional help consult the *Publication Manual of the APA* (6th ed.), ask a librarian, visit the MiraCosta Writing Center, and/or check out: library.miracosta.edu/apa

IN-TEXT CITATIONS

Place in-text citations at the end of sentences in your paper; include author, year, & pages (for direct quotations).

In-Text Citation When Paraphrasing

- According to one researcher, students learn best when they take notes (Gomez, 2016).
- In her research, Gomez found that students learn best when they take notes (2016).

In-Text Citation When Quoting

- According to Gomez (2016), "college students learn best when they are note taking" (p. 179).
- One scholar stated that "college students learn best when they are note taking" (Gomez, 2016, p. 179).

In-Text Citation for Sources with No Author

Give first few words of title in quotation marks and year:

- Kittens make humans significantly happier ("Kittens are Great," 2015).

In-Text Citation for Sources with 6+ authors

List **et al.** after first author: (Brown et al., 2017). On References page for sources with 7+ authors list the first six authors then an ellipsis (...) and final author.

REFERENCES PAGE

A References page is the final page of a research paper and should be **alphabetized** and **double-spaced**. All citations longer than one line should have a **.5 inch hanging indent**:
