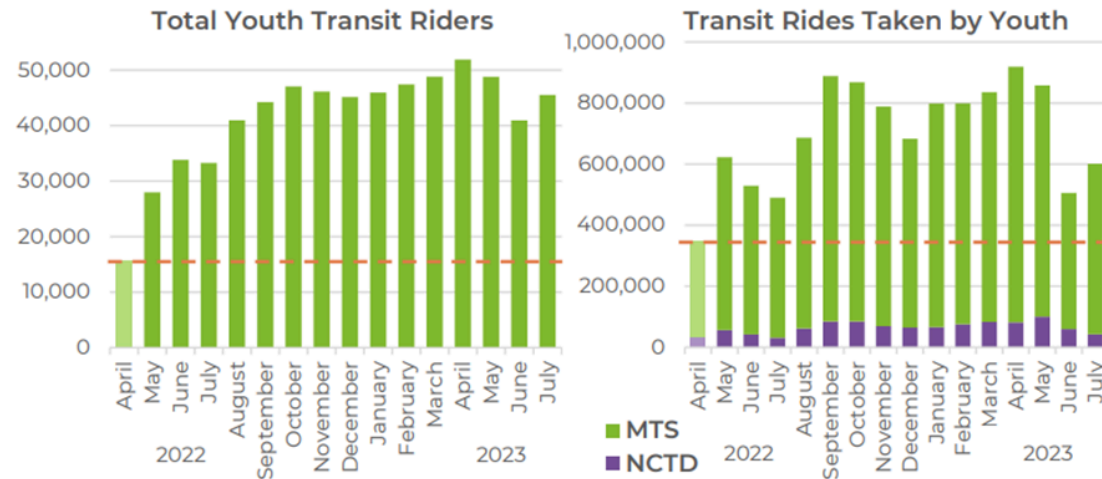

The service started in May 2022, so the dashed orange line is the base line. While MTS YOP ridership is substantial, NCTD YOP ridership is much, much less. This may be expected partly because of the smaller North County population and smaller NCTD geographic service area. But it looks like YOP could be much greater used by North County youth. There is an upcoming deadline for renewing Pronto passes for YOP, and I believe more youth can be informed to enter this program, through schools, youth service providers, etc. Attached is a one-page instruction sheet for getting or renewing YOP Pronto passes and apps.</li><li>○ <b>Second</b> - Speaking of transportation services, you may know of the nonprofit <b>FACT</b> (<a href="http://www.factsd.org">www.factsd.org</a>) Facilitated Access and Coordinated Transportation, Arun Prem the Exec Director. Through FACT, free or discounted transportation services for seniors/disabled, including disabled youth, can be provided. FACT and Arun have participated in ARS meetings.</li><li>○ FACT is involved in the latest SANDAG cycle of allocating dedicated funding for specialized trans. access services, and is reaching out for letters of support. I'm volunteering to help Arun with outreach. Attached is a support letter template, of course to be modified as suits an organization. 
